We may even know about saints like Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton who were teachers or started schools. The jubilee invites us to recognize more fully that the Church played a key role in the development of education in world history.

In the first generations of Christianity, new Christians were taught about Jesus. The earliest monks and nuns learned to read so they could pray with Scripture. Gradually, the Church helped develop schools and systems that now educate millions of people all over the world.

At the heart of Catholic education is always Jesus, who teaches, heals, and saves us. He gives us hope to build up the Kingdom of God and prepare for eternity.


